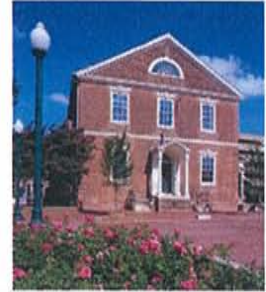

VIRGINIA BEACH, VIRGINIA

Featuring Colonial Williamsburg

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 -** A morning departure has you heading to your overnight stop where lodging awaits your arrival. *(Pack an overnight bag).*
- Day 2 -** Following **breakfast**, check out and continue traveling to Virginia Beach, VA. Arrive in Virginia Beach in the afternoon and check into your hotel. Tonight, enjoy **dinner** at one of Virginia Beach's finest restaurants.
- Day 3 -** After **breakfast**, board your motorcoach for **Colonial Williamsburg** where you will meet your guide for a 2-hour tour of Virginia's first capital. The first hour will be a riding tour of the historic countryside, then returned to the restored area for a guided walking tour. There will be time for lunch on your own and shopping in the village, then depart for the **Norfolk's Naval Base** where you will have a guided riding tour through the world's largest naval installation. Conducted by Navy personnel, you will ride past aircraft carriers, destroyers, submarines, frigates, amphibious assault ships and the historic homes from the 1907 Jamestown Exposition. Return to Virginia Beach where **dinner** has been arranged at another fine restaurant.
- Day 4 -** Enjoy **breakfast**, then depart for downtown Norfolk for a visit to two historic homes. Your first stop is the **Willoughby-Baylor House** which now houses the **Norfolk History Museum**. Next, visit the **Moses Myers House**, which draws an exceptionally accurate picture of the 18th-century life of this prosperous merchant and his family. The **General Douglas MacArthur Memorial** is also located nearby, and there is a 20-minute film which details events of the life of General MacArthur. You can spend some time wandering through the Memorial Building where MacArthur is buried and which houses many of his momentos from throughout his career. There will be time for lunch on your own at the adjacent MacArthur Center Mall, then stop at **Rowena's Jam & Jelly Factory** for a tour and chance to purchase some of their sweet delicacies. Later, board the **Spirit of Norfolk** for a delicious **buffet meal, entertainment and narrated cruise** as you sail along the Elizabeth River. After the cruise, visit **The Chrysler Museum of Art**, one of America's great fine arts museums and including the collection of automobile heir and art collector Walter P. Chrysler, Jr.
- Day 5 -** Following **breakfast**, depart for **Fort Monroe** where you will enjoy a guided tour through the fort which has been occupied since 1823. Also included is the **Casemate Museum**, housing artifacts and memorabilia of the fort's rich history along with the prison cell where Confederate President Jefferson Davis was confined until 1867. In the afternoon, return to Virginia Beach for a leisurely afternoon at the beach, pool, strolling the boardwalk or browsing the shops along Atlantic Avenue. **Dinner and entertainment** will complete your day.
- Day 6 -** **Breakfast**, then check out and depart for your last night of lodging. *(Pack an overnight bag.)*
- Day 7 -** After **breakfast**, check out and prepare for your departure home.
